EMERGENCY CHECK OFF LIST

MEASURES TO BE CONSIDERED IN THE EVENT OF:

(a) Rough weather at sea or crossing hazardous bars:

- a. All weathertight and watertight doors and hatches closed.
- b. Bilges kept dry to prevent loss of stability.
- c. Passengers seated and evenly distributed.
- d. All passengers wearing life preservers in conditions of very rough seas or if about to cross a bar under hazardous conditions.
- e. Call the Coast Guard if assistance is needed.

(b) Person Overboard: If you see or hear it - Notify captain immediately!

- a. MOB button pushed on GPS, and Williamson Curve performed.
- b. Hurl Throw Bag (first) and Ring Buoy (located in aft cockpit) as close to the victim as possible.
- c. Lookout posted to keep the victim in sight.
- d. Crewmember, wearing a life preserver and having a secured line, standing by ready to jump in to assist the victim back aboard.
- e. Swim ladder lowered.
- f. Coast Guard and all vessels in the vicinity notified by VHF radio.

(c) Fire at Sea

- a. Lift flab and push distress button on VHF to provide vessel ID and location!
- b. Air Supply to the fire cut off by closing hatches, ports, doors, and ventilators, etc.
- c. Portable extinguishers discharged at the base of the flames of flammable liquid or grease fires or water applied to fires in combustible solids.
- d. If fire is in machinery spaces, fuel supply and ventilation shut off and any installed fixed fire-fighting system discharged.
- e. Vessel maneuvered to minimize the effect of wind on the fire.
