

## Belfast Maine

Dockage or Moorings – thru Harbormaster, Kathy Given

Call 207-338-1142 or Channel 9 (VHF)

Approach –

Leave Red Bell “2” = at Steets Ledge to Starboard to starboard, then run up the middle of the channel toward the bridge. Nun “6” is among the moored boats, opposite the Town Landing (on your port side). Contact the Harbormaster for assignment before passing the Bell.

The harbor is a busy harbor so space out the arrivals. Fuel, Pump out and Water is available at the Town Landing, inside docks just before the Tugboats.

Downtown

Mainstreet is at the top of the town landing. Laundry, Hardware Store and a good Co-Op Food Store are located a couple blocks up the road. Lots of nice stores. Restaurants are located on Main Street as well as along the harbor walk, located just beyond the Transient Bath Rooms on Main Street near the town Landing.

Of special note, The Sequoia, former Presidential Yacht is in front of French and Webb’s Boat Building. This is a several year restoration being worked on.

Front Street Shipyard is also located along harbor walk to the West of Main Street. Tours of the yard can be arranged thru the Dock Masters Office. Always interesting projects and boats in the new, state of the art boat yard.
